NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **206 countries/territories** including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka state has strengthened all surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

“As of 5 pm of 2nd April 2020, 124 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed in the state which includes 3 deaths & 11 discharges”

- Out of 110, 107 COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and three *in ICU* (P43 on oxygen and P101 & P102 on Ventilators).

14 new cases have been confirmed in the state of Karnataka from 01.04.2020 5.00pm to 02.04.2020 5.00pm.

Today's Updates

1)	Hon'ble Prime Minister has conducted meeting with states on preparedness on COVID-19 which was attended by Chief Minister, Deputy Chief Ministers & other Ministers.
2)	In view of Medical emergency declared in the State, Chief Secretary and Member Secretary, Karnataka State Disaster Management Board has instructed all District Commissioners to consider relaxation on mandating of OTP for lifting Food grains from ration shops.
3)	The Commissioner, H&FW services has issued Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for health screening of laborers / workers residing at temporary shelters provided by Government in order to identify suspected and confirmed cases and to ensure control and avoid spreading of infection.
4)	Department of H&FW has instructed that, all those with history of attending the Tablighi Jamaat Congregation and who are asymptomatic and within 14 days of their arrival shall be quarantined at Government Monitored Quarantine Centre. Those who are beyond 14 days should be home quarantined in reporting period. (28 days from day of arrival)
5)	In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, 287 people with fever have been screened on 01.04.2020.
6)	Home Quarantine Enforcement squad have quarantined 52 persons in institutions yesterday based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 293 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
7)	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this department has arranged for mental health counseling of such patients and contacts 914 sessions were held on 01.04.2020 and so far 17,959 number of counseling sessions have been held.

9)	Appeal to Doctors has been issued by Hon'ble Chief Minister to give missed call to 08047192219 or sign up at https://forms.gle/TPbU7eZgazdxG9gS9 to volunteer for COVID-19 tele-medicine facility and to help the Government.
10)	Corona Watch mobile application can be downloaded from www.karnataka.gov.in . In the application you can see the spots visited by positive patients upto 14 days prior to testing positive. Also it shows the nearest First Respondent Hospitals and Helpline numbers.

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on 01.04.2020 calls 14,386 have been received and around 28,964 calls have outgone along with 36 manual calls has been done, for whom necessary guidance has been provided.

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in home isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. Also, should self-notify to nearest government hospital or call 104 health helpline. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.
