NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

MEDIA BULLETIN

Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **212 countries / territories** including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka state has strengthened all surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

On 08.04.2020, 92 individuals have been screened at Mangaluru port.

“As of 5:00 PM of 9th April 2020, cumulatively 197 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed in the state, it includes 6 deaths & 30 discharges”

Out of remaining 161 cases, 159 COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and 2 *in ICU* (P43 on oxygen and P101 on Ventilator).

16 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state from 08.04.2020, 5:00 PM to 09.04.2020 5:00 PM.

Programmatic Updates

1	Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) invites applications from all Government & Private Medical Colleges for establishing a COVID-19 testing facility. Applications should be submitted at: arvind.nccs@gmail.com & jitunarayan@gmail.com
2	In view of breaking the chain and containment of COVID-19, Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, Bengaluru has directed to all the managements not to allow any congregational prayers in the Masjid and the managements of the Qabrasthans (Muslim graveyards) / Darghas throughout the state and to suspend the visit of public on the occasion of SHAB-E-BARAT on thursday, 9 th April 2020. No public shall be allowed to perform religious rituals in the Qabrasthans / Darghas and all the gates of Qabrasthans / Darghas shall be kept closed. All managements of Qabrasthans / Darghas shall take necessary action on the above directions and all Waqf officers, District Waqf Advisory Committee in state shall adhere to the orders and directed to circulate the same and to ensure the order is followed scrupulously.
3	In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 193 people have been screened on 08.04.2020 and till on date 2535 people have been screened.
4	Home Quarantine Enforcement squad have quarantined 15 persons in institutions on 08.04.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 417 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
5	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this department has arranged for mental health counseling of such patients and contacts 1,338 sessions were held on 08.04.2020 and so far 28,898 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on 08.04.2020 calls 7,968 have been received and around 26,202 calls have outgone along with 31 manual calls has been done, for whom necessary guidance has been provided.

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in home isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. Also, should self-notify to nearest government hospital or call 104 health

helpline. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.
