**NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)**

**MEDIA BULLETIN**

**Evening Report**

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **212 Countries / Territories** including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

On 09.04.2020, 18 individuals have been screened at Karwar port.

**“As of 5:00 PM of 10<sup>th</sup> April 2020, Cumulatively 207 COVID-19 positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 6 Deaths & 34 Discharges”**

Out of remaining 167 cases, 163 COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and 4 **in ICU** (P43, P101, P108-K & P195).

10 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state from 09.04.2020, 5:00 PM to 10.04.2020 5:00 PM.

### Programmatic Updates

1	In view to spread Awareness and Effective Communication on COVID-19, Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has launched " <i>Aarogya Setu</i> ", Mobile App on 09.04.2020. Application can be downloaded from <i>Google play store and App store (Apple)</i> .
2	Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has released revised advisory on 08.04.2020 for management and suspect / confirmed cases of COVID-19.
3	Government of India sanctioned Rs.15,000 Crores for India COVID-19 Emergency Response and Health System preparedness package on 09.04.2020.
4	ICMR, Department of Health Research has released the list of 67 private laboratories to test COVID-19 across the Country on 09.04.2020, it includes 5 Laboratories from Karnataka. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i) Neuberg Anand Reference Laboratory, Anand Tower, #54, Bowring Hospital Road, Bengaluru.</li> <li>ii) Cancyte Technologies Pvt. - 5 In view to strengthen the screening and health services towards COVID-19 in urban areas, the Department of Health & Family Welfare has issued a circular to convert 50% of the Urban Primary Health Centers under National Urban Health Mission into **Fever Clinics** in the respective districts on need basis.
- 6 In the context of restricting District Hospitals for COVID-19 treatment centers, the Department of Health & Family Welfare – Suvarna Aarogya Suraksha Trust (SAST) has issued circular to all districts, to identify alternate hospitals in their respective districts to facilitate treatment of patients for all non COVID-19 health requirements. SAST shall provisionally empanel the hospitals that are identified by the Deputy Commissioners, which are not empanelled under it.
- 7 In continuation of the Government Notification No.JDM/KPME/69/2020-21 dated 02<sup>nd</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 the Department of Health & Family Welfare has further notified the following new 14 Hospitals as dedicated COVID-19 Hospitals

- 8 In **31** Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 220 people have been screened on 09.04.2020 and till on date 2755 people have been screened.
- 9 Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 15 persons in Institutions on 09.04.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 432 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
- 10 The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this department has arranged for **Mental Health Counseling** of such patients and contacts **1,531 sessions were held on 09.04.2020** and so far 30,429 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on 09.04.2020 calls 7,676 have been received and around 12,279 calls have outgone along with 19 manual calls has been done, for whom necessary guidance has been provided.

**Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected Countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in Home Isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call 104 – Arogya Sahayavani, Health Helpline. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.**
