Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **213 Countries / Territories including India** till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

“As of 5:00 PM of 25th April 2020, Cumulatively 500 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 18 Deaths & 158 Discharges”

Out of remaining **324** cases, **317** COVID-19 positive patients (including 1 pregnant woman, P-176) are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **7 in ICU** (P-101, P-273, P-349, P-369, P-409, P-465 & P-466).

26 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state **from 24.04.2020, 5:00 PM to 25.04.2020, 5:00 PM.**

Programmatic Updates

1	In continuation to the Order No.40-3/2020-DM 1(A) Dated 15th April 2020 from Home Affairs, Ministry of Home Affairs government of India has issued amendments and given some Modifications and Inclusions for the Consolidated revised COVID-19 Guidelines, for strict implementation by States /UTs. (Ref. No. 40-3/2020-DM 1(A) Dated.24-04-2020).
2	With regards to the State specific Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) and Micro plans for Covid-19 containment issued by GOI, Commissioner Health and Family Welfare, Karnataka , has issued "Specific Action plan and clarified COVID-19 guidelines for effective implementation and instructed to ensure strict actions in Containment Zones in respective Districts. (Ref. No. SSU/COVID-19/07/2021 Dated.24/04/2020).
3	Commissioner Health & Family Welfare Services has given instruction to all district, Contact tracing App Should be mandatorily used, Reporting / entering data of Primary & Secondary Contact Covid-19 The mobile app can downloaded by the authorized person. (Ref. No. DHS/SSU/COVID- 19/17/19-20 Dated.24-04-2020)
4	On 24-04-2020 : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 151 people have been screened and till on date 5178 people have been screened. • In 453 Fever Clinics of State, in total 8297 people have been screened and till on date 120009 people have been screened. • In 33 Fever Clinics of Private Hospital and Colleges were operationalized, in Total 1061 people have been screened and till on date 4934 people have been screened.
5	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 18 persons in Institutions on 24.04.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 697 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
6	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 851 sessions were held on 24.04.2020 and so far 48630 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.
