Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **215 Countries / Territories including India** till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

**“As of 5:00 PM of 02st May 2020, cumulatively 601 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 25 Deaths & 271 Discharges”
+1 death due to non – Covid Cause.**

Out of remaining **304** cases, **297** COVID-19 positive patients are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **07** in ICU (P-101, P-247, P-298, P-349, P-419, P-498 & P-536).

12 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state **from 01.05.2020, 5:00 PM to 02.05.2020, 5:00 PM.**

1	<p>In continuation to the Consolidated Revised Guidelines for COVID-19, issued on 24th April 2020 Ministry of Home affairs GOI, has issued orders on Movement of migrant workers, Pilgrims, tourists, Students and other persons, Stranded at different places, is also allowed by special trains to be operated by Ministry of Railways. (Ref. No. 40-3/2020 DM-I (A) Dated:01.05.2020)</p> <p>For those who want to travel from other States to Karnataka and also from Karnataka to other states can register at https://sevasindhu.karnataka.gov.in /Sevasindhu/English Kindly note this is only registration. The actual travel details and mode of travel will be intimated later</p>
2	<p>Ministry of Home affairs, GOI has issued orders on Extension of COVID-19 lockdown for a further period of two weeks with effect from 04.05.2020. Issued new guidelines on lockdown measures, for strict implementation by states/UTs. (Ref. No. 40-3/2020 DM-I (A) Dated: 01.05.2020).</p>
3	<p>Commissioner, Health and family welfare Services, Karnataka has issued Official Memorandum for training of all Private medical institutions/ Establishments on software application, developed by health department to keep and data enter the records of all patients who are being treated as ILI/SARI in the state. Asked all IMA, PHANA, AYUSH associations for training and coordination. The web portal https://kpme.karnataka.tech/ allows each KPME to login and enter patient data. This training is scheduled on 04.05.2020 at 11.00 am and will be live on Jagruthi Karnataka.</p>
4	<p>On 01.05.2020:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 158 people have been screened and till on date 6190 people have been screened. • In 527 Fever Clinics of State, in total 8392 people have been screened and till on date 184909 people have been screened. • In 100 Fever Clinics of Private Hospital and Colleges were operationalized, in Total 1138 people have been screened and till on date 11515 people have been screened.

5	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 37 persons in Institutions on 01.05.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 856 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
6	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 1714 sessions were held on 01.05.2020 and so far 60255 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.

12	During this COVID-19 pandemic lockdown period in the State for assisting public on fever, cold, cough & respiratory problem a unique helpline Number 14410 called "Aptamitra" is started by Government of Karnataka .

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on **01.05.2020** calls **6771** have been received. **9190** calls have been attended on **01.05.2020** and **43397** cumulative calls have been attended in **"Apthamitra"** Helpline

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected Countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in Home Isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. **Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call "Aptamitra" Helpline 14410. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.**
