Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **215 Countries / Territories including India** till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

“As of 5:00 PM of 04th May 2020, cumulatively 651 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 27 Deaths & 321 Discharges”
+1 death due to non – Covid Cause.

Out of remaining **302** cases, **296** COVID-19 positive patients are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **06 in ICU** (P-101, P-349, P-419, P-536, P-565 & P-640).

37 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state **from 03.05.2020, 5:00 PM to 04.05.2020, 5:00 PM.**

1	<p>In continuation to the Government Order No. RD 158 TNR 2020 Dtd.02.05.2020 on New Guidelines on lockdown measures for the period of two weeks in the State, The Chief Secretary and Chairman, State executive Committee, Karnataka State Disaster management Authority, has issued the Orders on “Permitting movement of individuals and vehicles to undertake permitted activities in the Bengaluru Rural, Bengaluru Urban, Ramanagara, Chikkaballapura and Kolar districts (treating as single unit) and conditions for other Districts”. (Ref. No. RD 158 TNR 2020 Dated.03.05.2020)</p>
2	<p>Government Order No. AaEe 114 EXP 11/2020, Dtd.02.05.2020 Secretary (Budget & resource), Department of Finance, Government of Karnataka, has issued Government Order on considering all Anganwadi workers/ Helpers, Police Officers/Staff, Home Guards, Civil Defense force, Fire brigade staffs/Officers, Jail staffs, Municipal / Sanitary workers , related vehicle Drivers/ loaders Will be covered under the “Pradhana Manthri Gareeb Kalyan Yojana” and are eligible for Rs.30.00 lakh relief, if they are involved and died due to COVID-19 infection. (Ref. No. ಆಇ 114 ವೆಚ್ಚ 11/2020, Dated: 02.05.2020).</p>
3	<p>In continuation to the GOI order No.40-3/2020-DM-I (A) dated 29th April 2020 and 1st May 2020, “Movement of migrant workers, pilgrims, tourists, students and other persons who are stranded different places due to lockdown”. It is clarified that the order is for facilitate movement of such above said stranded persons, but does not extend to those categories of persons, who are otherwise residing normally at places, other than the native places for purpose of work etc., and who wish to visit their native places in normal course. (Ref. No.40-10/2020-DM-I (A) dated: 3rd May 2020).</p>
4	<p>Govt. of Karnataka has issued orders for Immediate relocation of RT-PCR Machines available in University of Agriculture Sciences and Veterinary Colleges to ICMR approved 6 laboratories in the state. (Ref. No. HFW 150 CGM 2020 Dated: 04.05.2020).</p>

5	Govt. of Karnataka has issued order to “All private medical colleges in the state of Karnataka and ESIC Medical Colleges Functioning at Bengaluru and kalaburgi districts in Karnataka are hereby directed to establish the RT-PCR Laboratories for the diagnosis of COVID-19 day”. (Ref. No. MED 130 MSF 2020 Dated: 29.04.2020.)
6	On 03.05.2020: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 82 people have been screened and till on date 6398 people have been screened. In 527 Fever Clinics of State, in total 7807 people have been screened and till on date 206249 people have been screened. In 100 Fever Clinics of Private Hospital and Colleges were operationalized, in Total 850 people have been screened and till on date 13796 people have been screened.
7	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 07 persons in Institutions on 03.05.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 877 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
8	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 1064 sessions were held on 03.05.2020 and so far 63308 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.
9	In view to spread Awareness and Effective Communication on COVID-19, Govt. of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has lunched “Aarogya Setu” Mobile app on 09.04.2020. Application can downloaded from Google Play store and App store (Apple) .

11	Minority Welfare, Waqf and Hajj Department, Govt of Karnataka has issued Order for suspension of congressional prayers (Salat) and guidelines for Ramadan in The Masajid/Darghs due to COVID-19 upto 03-05-2020. (Ref. No. MWD/2/MDS/2020, Bengaluru. Dated: 16-04-2020).
12	Appeal to Doctors has been issued by Hon’ble Chief Minister to give missed call to 080-47192219 or signup at https://forms.gle/TPbU7eZgazdxG9gS9 to volunteer for COVID-19 Tele-Medicine facility and to help the Government.
13	“Corona Watch” Mobile Application can be downloaded from https://covid19.karnataka.gov.in In the application you can see the spots visited by positive patients up to 14 days prior to testing positive. Also it shows the nearest First Respondent Hospitals and Helpline numbers.
14	During this COVID-19 pandemic lockdown period in the State for assisting public on fever, cold, cough & respiratory problem a unique helpline Number 14410 called “Aptamitra” is started by Government of Karnataka.

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on 03.05.2020 calls 8208 have been received.

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected Countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in Home Isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call “Aptamitra” Helpline 14410. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.
