Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **215 Countries / Territories including India** till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

**“As of 5:00 PM of 05th May 2020, cumulatively 673 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 29 Deaths & 331 Discharges”
+1 death due to non – Covid Cause.**

Out of remaining **312** cases, **306** COVID-19 positive patients are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **06 in ICU** (P-101, P-349, P-419, P-536, P-565 & P-654).

22 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state **from 04.05.2020, 5:00 PM to 05.05.2020, 5:00 PM.**
