Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **215 Countries / Territories including India** till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

**“As of 5:00 PM of 06th May 2020, cumulatively 693 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 29 Deaths & 354 Discharges”
+1 death due to non – Covid Cause.**

Out of remaining **309** cases, **303** COVID-19 positive patients are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **06 in ICU** (P-101, P-349, P-419, P-536, P-565 & P-654).

20 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state **from 05.05.2020, 5:00 PM to 06.05.2020, 5:00 PM.**

1	In continuation to the Government Order R 158 TNR 2020, Dtd.03.05.2020 for extension of Lockdown for two weeks period up to 17.05.2020, The Chief Secretary and Chairman, Karnataka State Disaster Management Authority , has issued clarification....., Only those Hotels/ Restaurants providing food supply services to Hostels, Health, Police, Government officers, Health workers and travelers stranded at different places and Quarantine places facilities are permitted to function. Other Hotels and Restaurants can provide take away and Home delivery only.(Ref. R 158 TNR 2020 (P1), Dtd.06.05.2020)
2	In continuation to the Government Circular NHM/7/MD, NHM/2020-21, Dtd.02.05.2020 on USE of RT-PCR app, The Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Health and Family Welfare Department and Medical Education Department, has issued circular that From 7 th May 2020 onwards, none of the COVID-19 Testing Laboratories should accept samples with manually filled SRFs (Specimen Referral Form), only samples with SRFs filled on RT-PCR app should be accepted. (Ref. HFW 142 ACS 2020, Dtd.06.05.2020)
3	In continuation to the Government of India decision to allow Interstate travel of migrant workers, pilgrims, tourist, students and other persons stranded in different states due to lockdown, Commissioner Health and Family Welfare Services, Karnataka , has issued Quarantine guidelines and Standard Operative Procedures (SOP) for screening and management. (Commissioner letter Dated.05.05.2020)
4	Department of AYUSH, Government of Karnataka , has issued advisory on improving resistance power towards on COVID-19 and healthy development.
5	On 05.05.2020 : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 139 people have been screened and till on date 6655 people have been screened. • In 528 Fever Clinics of State, in total 16849 people have been screened and till on date 242071 people have been screened. • In 101 Fever Clinics of Private Hospital and Colleges were operationalized, in Total 1891 people have been screened and till on date 16881 people have been screened.
6	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 134 persons in Institutions on 05.05.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 1027 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
7	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 2792 sessions were held on 05.05.2020 and so far 75318 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.
