Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **215 Countries / Territories including India** till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

**“As of 5:00 PM of 07th May 2020, cumulatively 705 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 30 Deaths & 366 Discharges”
+1 death due to non – Covid Cause.**

Out of remaining **308** cases, **302** COVID-19 positive patients are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **06 in ICU** (P-101, P-349, P-419, P-536, P-565 & P-654).

12 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state **from 06.05.2020, 5:00 PM to 07.05.2020, 5:00 PM.**

1	In continuation to the Government order No. RD 158 TNR 2020, on allowing inter-state travel of migrant workers, pilgrims, tourists, students and other persons stranded in different states due to lockdown, Principal Secretary to Government, Revenue Department (Disaster management) has given the procedures and list, of identified Entry and Exits points for 18 Districts in Karnataka. (Ref.No RD 158 TNR 2020, Dtd.06.05.2020)
2	Additional Chief Secretary to government, Health and Family Welfare Department, has issued circular for <i>Categorization of the sample collected for COVID-19 testing, on basis of priority.</i> (Ref.No HFW 138 ACS 2020, Dtd.02.05.2020)
3	Considering the possibility of increase in cases of COVID-19, a view is taken to utilize Railway coaches for COVID Care Centre (CCC), Ministry of Family & Health Welfare Directorate General of Health Services EMR Division GoI, has issued Guidance for appropriate management of suspected/confirmed cases of COVID-19. (MoHFW website . Published Dtd. 07.05.2020)
4	Ministry of Civil Aviation SD&IT Division, Government of India, has issued Conditional exemption to Government entities for COVID-19 related Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS-commonly known as “drones”) operations. (Ref. AV-22011/2/2020-SDnIT-MoCA, Dtd.02.05.2020)
5	In view to provide COVID-19 Quarantine facilities in private hotels as a last option in the state, Joint Secretary to Government, Revenue Department (Disaster management and register and stamp, has issued Revised Rate list for the Quarantine Hotel stays. (Ref.No. Kam E ,20 Pra Ka Bengaluru Dtd.06.05.2020)
6	In continuation to the Home affairs, GoI order No.40.-3/2020-DM-I (A), Dtd.01.05.2020, on extension of lockdown period for further two weeks, The Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Department of Health and Family Welfare, and Medical education, Karnataka, has issued Advisory to Information Technology/ ITES and Business Process Management Sectors. (Ref.No HFW 141 ACS 2020 Dtd,03.05.2020)
7	In order to enable the Industrial operations to restart, the Government in its Order no.RD 158 TNR 2020 Dtd.23.04.2020, government has allowed industries to operate in rural areas of specified COVID-19 Unaffected Districts. (Ref.No CI 06 SPI 2020 Dtd. 04.05.2020)
8	On 06.05.2020: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 149 people have been screened and till on date 6804 people have been screened. • In 528 Fever Clinics of State, in total 16028 people have been screened and till on date 258099 people have been screened. • In 101 Fever Clinics of Private Hospital and Colleges were operationalized, in Total 1886 people have been screened and till on date 18767 people have been screened.
9	Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 83 persons in Institutions on 06.05.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 1110 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.
10	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long

	duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 2631 sessions were held on 06.05.2020 and so far 70749 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.
11	In view to spread Awareness and Effective Communication on COVID-19, Govt. of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has launched “ Aarogya Setu ” Mobile app on 09.04.2020 . Application can downloaded from Google Play store and App store (Apple) .

15	“ Corona Watch ” Mobile Application can be downloaded from https://covid19.karnataka.gov.in In the application you can see the spots visited by positive patients up to 14 days prior to testing positive. Also it shows the nearest First Respondent Hospitals and Helpline numbers.
16	During this COVID-19 pandemic lockdown period in the State for assisting public on fever, cold, cough & respiratory problem a unique helpline Number 14410 called “ Aptamitra ” is started by Government of Karnataka .

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19 on **06.05.2020** calls **6332** have been received.

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected Countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in Home Isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. **Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call “Aptamitra” Helpline 14410. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.**
