Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **215 Countries / Territories including India** till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

**“As of 5:00 PM of 09th May 2020, cumulatively 794 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 30 Deaths & 386 Discharges”
+1 death due to non – Covid Cause.**

Out of remaining **377** cases, **371** COVID-19 positive patients are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **06** in ICU.

41 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state **from 08.05.2020, 5:00 PM to 09.05.2020, 5:00 PM.**

3	<p>Additional Chief Secretary to the Government, Department of Health & Family Welfare has issued guidelines for all Private Medical Establishments, Registered under KPME Act for non-COVID health care facilities as well as Dental Establishments during COVID-19 pandemic in the state. 6	<p>On 08.05.2020:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 214 people have been screened and till on date 7216 people have been screened.• In 528 Fever Clinics of State, in total 13239 people have been screened and till on date 288199 people have been screened.• In 102 Fever Clinics of Private Hospital and Colleges were operationalized, in Total 1458 people have been screened and till on date 21846 people have been screened.
7	<p>Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 34 persons in Institutions on 08.05.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 1183 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.</p>
8	<p>The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 1639 sessions were held on 08.05.2020 and so far 74462 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.</p>

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected Countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in Home Isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. **Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call “Aptamitra” Helpline 14410. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.**
