Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **215 Countries / Territories including India** till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the possible spread of disease.

**“As of 5:00 PM of 11th May 2020, cumulatively 862 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, it includes 31 Deaths & 426 Discharges”
+1 death due to non – Covid Cause.**

Out of remaining **404** cases, **395** COVID-19 positive patients are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **09** in ICU.

14 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state **from 10.05.2020, 5:00 PM to 11.05.2020, 5:00 PM.**

1	<p>In continuation to the orders from Ministry of home affairs, Government of India, No.40-3/2020-Dm-I (A) Dated 1st and 5th May 2020, GOI has issued "Standard Operative Procedures (SOP) for movement of persons by train, and insisted states for strict implementation. (Ref. No: 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) Dated.11.05.2020)</p>
2	<p>"Indian Railways" plans to gradually restart passenger trains operations from 12th May 2020. Initially with 15 pairs of special trains, includes train from New-Delhi to Bengaluru. (Ref. Press Information Bureau, GOI. Posted on 10th May 2020 by PIB Delhi.)</p>
3	<p>Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has issued Revised guidelines for "Home Isolation" of very few/ pre-symptomatic COVID-19 cases. (Letter. Dated: 10.05.2020).</p>
4	<p>On 10.05.2020:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• In 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in total 139 people have been screened and till on date 7561 people have been screened.• In 531 Fever Clinics of State, in total 10085 people have been screened and till on date 315836 people have been screened.• In 104 Fever Clinics of Private Hospital and Colleges were operationalized, in Total 1545 people have been screened and till on date 25342 people have been screened.
5	<p>Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 61 persons in Institutions on 10.05.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 1555 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine.</p>
6	<p>The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quite. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts 1047 sessions were held on 10.05.2020 and so far 77087 number of counseling sessions have been held counseling sessions for migrants.</p>
7	<p>In view to spread Awareness and Effective Communication on COVID-19, Govt. of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has lunched "Aarogya Setu" Mobile app on 09.04.2020. Application can downloaded from Google Play store and App store (Apple).</p>

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected Countries or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in Home Isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. **Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call "Aptamitra" Helpline 14410. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.**
