Evening Report

World Health Organization has declared the recent Novel Corona Virus, COVID-19 as **Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC)** which has affected **216 Countries / Territories** including India till date. WHO has characterized COVID-19 as a **Pandemic** on 11th March 2020.

In this context, Karnataka State has strengthened all Surveillance and containment measures against the spread of infection and prevent morbidity and mortality .

**“As of 6:00 PM of 14th May 2020, cumulatively 987 COVID-19 Positive cases have been confirmed in the State, Which includes 35 Deaths & 460 Discharges”
+1 death due to non – Covid Cause.**

Out of remaining **491** active cases, **482** COVID-19 positive patients are in isolation at designated hospitals are stable and **09** in ICU (P-298, P-610, P-642, P-805, P-806, P-807, P-859, P-865 & P-911).

28 new cases have been confirmed for COVID-19 in the state **from 13.05.2020, 5:00 PM to 14.05.2020, 6:00 PM.**

P-507, 80 years Female resident of Dakshina Kannada, got admitted at private hospital with complaint of stroke, on confirmation for Covid-19 was shifted to ICU, designated hospital Dakshina Kannada on 26.04.2020. Died on 14.05.2020 due to Septic shock.

P-796, 60 years Male, resident of Ananthapur Andhra Pradesh admitted at designated hospital Bengaluru Urban with features of severe pneumonia and respiratory distress with hypotension, known case of Diabetes Mellitus. Died on 14.05.2020 due to Cardiac Arrest.

Programmatic Updates

1	<p>In Continuation to the Guidelines/ SOPs for Person entering to Karnataka from other states, the Additional chief Secretary to the Government, Department of Health and family Welfare, Karnataka has issued circular for Exemption from Institutional Quarantine to certain category of passenger found to be negative based on RT-PCR test and shall be sent to home Quarantine for 14-Days, from the date of arrival. (Ref. No. HFW 151 ACS 2020, Dtd.14.05.2020).</p>
2	<p>In continuation to the Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs), for entry of persons from other states to Karnataka addendums issued by Department of Health and Family Welfare, GOK, The Commissioner, BBMP, has issued specific SOPs for entry to Bengaluru Urban, Bengaluru Rural and BBMP area. (COMM/CWR/SOP-2/2020-21, Dtd.13.05.2020).</p>
3	<p>On 13.05.2020:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 31 Fever Clinics of BBMP, in the day 209 people and till date 8170 people have been screened. • 532 Fever Clinics of State, in the day 16678 people and till date 363553 people have been screened. • 104 Fever Clinics of Private Hospital and Medical Colleges were operationalized and the day 2516 people and till date 31472 people have been screened.
4	<p>Home Quarantine Enforcement Squad have quarantined 14 persons in Institutions on 13.05.2020 based on the complaints received from public & totally till date 1694 have been shifted from home Quarantine to institutional quarantine for violation of directions.</p>

5	The positive cases and suspects hospitalized in the designated hospitals and quarantined persons will be staying there for a minimum period of 14 days or till the successive samples of the positive case are proved negative or as per the treating physicians advice. This long duration of stay in isolation requires a mental booster for keeping oneself calm & quiet. Foreseeing this Department has arranged for Mental Health Counseling of such patients and contacts. 2116 sessions were held on 13.05.2020 and so far 83808 numbers of counseling sessions have been held.
6	To spread Awareness and Effective Communication on COVID-19, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India has launched “ Aarogya Setu ” Mobile App on 09.04.2020 . Application can be downloaded from Google Play store and App store (Apple) .

8	Minority Welfare, Waqf and Hajj Department , Govt. of Karnataka has issued Order for suspension of congressional prayers (Salat) and guidelines for Ramadan in The Masjids/Darghs due to COVID-19 upto 03-05-2020. (No. MWD/2/MDS/2020, Dtd: 16-04-20).
9	Appeal to Doctors has been issued by Hon’ble Chief Minister to give missed call to 080-47192219 or signup at https://forms.gle/TPbU7eZgazdxG9gS9 to volunteer for COVID-19 Tele-Medicine facility and to help the Government.
10	“ Corona Watch ” Mobile App can be downloaded from https://covid19.karnataka.gov.in . In this app you can see the spots visited by positive patients up to 14 days prior to testing positive. Also it shows the nearest First Respondent Hospitals and Helpline numbers.
11	During the COVID-19 lockdown period, for assisting public on fever, cold, cough & respiratory problems a unique helpline Number 14410 called “ Aptamitra ” has been started by Government of Karnataka .

210 lines have been reserved for receiving calls of COVID-19. On **13.05.2020**, **6826** calls have been received.

Appeal to Public: Any person who has returned from COVID-19 affected Country or has been in personal contact with such person must remain in Home Isolation for 14 days from arrival in India irrespective of having any symptoms or not. **Also, should self-notify to nearest Government Hospital or free call “Aptamitra” Helpline 14410. Maintain personal hygiene, use tissue paper/handkerchief while coughing or sneezing, frequently wash hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer and avoid attending mass social gatherings.**
